An Entry Review — Organisational is a short, fixed-fee written product. Its job is to help you make one specific decision: whether a full Threshold Organisational review is the right next step, or whether something else is.

The deliverable

1. One structured written document, roughly ten to twelve pages

Authored by a named ORVIA reviewer, reviewed by the Founder.

2. Neutral restatement of the concern

So we can check we have understood it before spending more of your money.

3. Independent framing

Where this concern sits against typical patterns ORVIA sees in similar settings.

4. Three to five named observations

Drawn from the situation you describe and the public evidence available.

5. Named gaps and risks

The material we would need to see to draw firmer conclusions.

6. A single named recommendation on next step

Full review · internal action · external route (LADO / regulator / commissioner) · no ORVIA product needed.

7. What is out of scope

The things an Entry Review deliberately does not do.

How it moves

This service follows the ORVIA enquiry journey — every enquiry passes Gate One (suitability), then Gate Two (controlled onboarding) before any evidence is examined. See the How it works page on orvia.org.uk for the full flow.
